We are honored to currently provide behavioral health care to approximately 1,400 individuals and families at our Granville Pike locations and another 973 who reside in Pickerington, Violent Township, Canal Winchester and surrounding communities.

Unfortunately, we have been hit hard by state budget cuts in the last two years. Ohio Department of Mental Health funding filters down to communities through local Alcohol Drug Addiction and Mental Health Boards (ADAMH Boards). Over the last two years we have incurred major reductions in our Fairfield County ADAMH Board funding. This has forced us to curtail the availability of the sliding-fee-scale for individuals and families who don't have health insurance, Medicaid or the ability to pay our full fee. Regrettably, this curtailment became effective in April, 2010 and will continue indefinitely.

Our Crisis Intervention service remains available at the Fairfield Medical Center emergency room on a 24/7 basis, every single day of the year. These services are provided without regard to income or ability to pay. Our mission is to improve the health and well-being of our clients and our community.
